

## Subject: Alternator R&R

**Flat Rate Code** – E-2001 Alternator R&R Includes Testing (Refer to Flat Tate Guide for time allowance).

- 1. Remove the negative battery cable from the battery to avoid electrical short circuits which could result in fire or explosion.
- 2. Remove the engine's beauty cover for access to alternator.
- 3. Remove the flame arrestor.
- 4. Remove the serpentine belt. Refer to SA2015-2.
- 5. Remove the two hex head cap screws that hold the beauty cover bracket and the alternator to the alternator bracket.
- 6. Position the alternator so you can disconnect the ground (black) wire, the positive (red or orange) wire, and the voltage reference/exciter wire plug.



## Installation

- 1. Connect the positive lead, the voltage reference/exciter lead and the negative lead to the appropriate terminals on the alternator.
- 2. Reposition the alternator and beauty cover and attach with the fasteners that you removed earlier. Follow the torque specification from the previous page.
- 3. Reinstall the serpentine belt. Refer to SA2015-2.
- 4. Reinstall the flame arrestor.
- 5. Reinstall the engine's beauty cover.
- 6. Reconnect the negative battery cable.
